Admission to Four-Year BBA (Hons.) and BCA (Hons.) Programmes –Academic Year-2026–27 Process of Application Invitation, Entrance Examination and Centralized Allotment will be Conducted by LBS Centre for Science and Technology.

Applications are invited for admission to the Four-Year Bachelor of Business Administration -BBA (Hons.) and Bachelor of Computer Applications -BCA (Hons.) programmes in the institutions affiliated to APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University for the academic year 2026–27. Admission to these programmes will be based on the Entrance Examination conducted by the LBS Centre for Science and Technology, as authorised by the University vide U.O.No. 969/2026/KTU Thiruvananthapuram, dated: 25.04.2026.

The University has introduced a **Three-Year Exit Option** in the Four-Year BCA Degree Programme and the Four-Year BBA Degree Programme for students admitted from the Academic Year **2026–27** onwards, vide **U.O. No. 1413/2026/KTU, Thiruvananthapuram, dated 23.06.2026.**

Educational Qualification:

- **BCA**

A pass in Higher Secondary or any other examination recognized as equivalent with at least 45% marks with 5% relaxation for the SC/ST students.

OR

A pass in diploma in Engineering/Commercial Practice or equivalent with at least 45% marks with 5% relaxation for the SC/ST students.

- **BBA**

The candidate should have a pass in Higher Secondary or equivalent thereto with any subject Combination with a minimum of 45% marks in aggregate with 5% relaxation for the SC/ST students.
